


Heart Wand DIY Guide

For best results, print on 8.5x11 paper

Materials:

- ♥ 3in x 7in piece of felt for large hearts
- ♥ (optional) 1.5in x 3in piece of felt for small hearts
- ♥ Ribbon in (3) complementary colors cut into (3) 7in pairs (eg: 2 red, 2 pink, 2 white)
- ♥ 8" craft dowel or an unused chopstick (really!)
- ♥ Needle & thread to match your felt color(s)
- ♥ Needle & white or contrasting embroidery floss for the finishing blanket stitch.
- ♥ Felt or fabric scraps, polyfill, or quilt batting for stuffing
- ♥ Scissors, hot glue, and fray stop / superglue / clear nail polish to seal your ribbon ends.



This line is 7 inches long; use it to measure your ribbon.



Instructions:

1. Using the templates, cut out (2) large hearts from your first piece of felt.
2. If you are making a 2-color heart, cut out (2) small hearts from your second piece of fabric. Then, using thread to match your small hearts, sew each small heart to the center of a large heart.
3. Sew your two large hearts "wrong side" together, leaving the bottom bit open.
4. Stuff your heart with felt or fabric scraps, polyfill, or quilt batting.
5. Hot glue the top 1in of your stick to the bottom 1in inside one of the large hearts
6. Rearrange your ribbon pairs so you have two matching sets of three. Hot glue one set on each side of your stick, inside the hearts.
7. Finish sewing up the remainder of your large hearts.
8. Use white or contrasting embroidery floss to blanket stitch around the outside of your stuffed two-sided heart wand.
9. Use fray stop / superglue / clear nail polish to seal your ribbon ends.
